### Expanding Horizons

**Smart Classrooms:** We have smart learning spaces with sophisticated software, interactive modules, smartboards, and audiovisual aids. Smart Classroom provides advanced tools for faculty to incorporate a wide range of media in instruction and to enrich student learning experience.
