Objectives:

- 1. To increase the number of admissions.
- 2. To maintain the proliferation of quality education in our institution.
- 3. To inculcate the best educational standards and ethics.
- 4. To attract and inspire meritorious students to join our college.
- 5. To motivate students to score good marks in university examinations.

(I) Merit Award for Under Graduate Students (All Streams)

The basis for Merit Award in Session 2023-24

Year	Basis
Ist year	Marks obtained in class 12 th
IInd year	Marks obtained in 1st year
IIIrd year	Marks obtained in 2nd year

Merit Award Criteria for Admissions in session 2023-24 will be as under :-

A. First year

Categary	Percentage Marks obtained in 12th	Merit Award - First Year
M- 1	School / College Topper	50%
M- 2	Above 95% (For All Streams)	25%
M- 3	Above 90% to 95% (For All Streams)	20%

B. 2nd and 3rd year

This rebate will be available to the students who have availed the rebate in their 1st year, no new students will get in 2nd or 3rd year.

Category – M-1 (School / College Topper)

School Topper merit award will be continued in the subsequent year only when she is the topper in her course in our college also.

(I) Rebate for the PG Students (All Streams) (Session 2022-23)

- Special 20% rebate on PG admission for pass out students irrespective of their percentage from our college.
- For outsider students (who did not graduate from our college), the relaxation
 of Rs. 1000 in total fee (on depositing the entire fee at the time of admission).

Terms & Conditions:

- Merit Award as above will be provided when complete fees (Net) is deposited at the time of Admission itself.
- 2. The Merit Award will be given to the students having annual income upto Rs.5 lakhs excluding students failing under the criteria of above 95% in class 12th. Documents required as income proof:
 - a) ITR copy or
 - b) Employer Certificate or
 - c) Income Certificate
- In any case, the revaluation result will not be considered for this Merit Award policy.

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- 4. In the following years, Merit Award will be given to the student based on the above-mentioned percentage slab with 75% overall attendance.
- 5. If the student avails scholarship from the R.K. Foundation then she will not be allowed to get a Merit Award fee as mentioned above and any other scholarship.
- 6. In case when a student takes a scholarship from Shri Ratanlal Kanwarlal Patni Foundation but wants to avail other government scholarships, then she has to surrender the scholarship received from the Foundation.
- 7. Our institution reserves the right to change or alter or modify or cancel any terms and conditions of the Merit Award at any point in time.

<u>Procedure to avail "Fee Rebate" by the students:</u>

- 1. The student will fill out the admission form and submit all details and requisite documents to the Help Desk.
- 2. After verification by the admission committee, the Principal will further verify the details.
- Depending upon the terms and conditions the adjustment of the rebate will be done by the Accounts section after the verification by the Principal.

(III) Scholarship for Sports Player:

S.No.	Criteria	Rebate in Fee
1	International Level	50%
2	National Level	30%
3	State Level	20%

Note: Old students who are studying in the college and availed Merit Award (Rebate) under sports quota will continue to get Merit Award as they got rebate at the time of admission.

Procedure:

 The student has to fill out the admission form and submit all details and requisite documents for availing Merit Award under the sports quota.



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- 2. After verification by admission and the sports committee, the Principal will further verify the details.
- 3. Depending upon the terms and conditions the adjustment of the rebate will be done by the accounts section after verification by the Principal and approval of the Director & Secretary.

(IV) Baba Saheb Award: -

Baba Saheb Award to 1st to 10th position holders in the University main examination (cumulative in all three years) will be given a cash prize of Rs. 11,000 each.

Procedure:

- 1. Position holders will be identified based on Merit List issued by the University as per their merit rules & approved by Principal and Director & Secretary.
- 2. Felicitation of the student for academic performance with the Baba Saheb Award will be through the Chairman/members of the management committee.
- 3. Appreciation and Reward to all the faculty members of the concerned department are expected as per the discretion of the management.

(V) Chabra Scholarship – 10 students per year

- 1. Class 12th students having family income less than Rs. 2.5 lakh.
- 2. Percentage of last qualifying exam (12th Board) 60% (Arts and commerce)
- 3. Percentage of last qualifying exam (12th Board) 70% (Science)
- 4. Note: The scholarship will be continued in 2nd and 3rd year if the student (All Streams) maintains minimum 60% in the last qualifying exams.
- 5. Merit Award shall be granted up to 50% of the fees.
- 6. Final approval of students uder this scholarship shall be given by Director & Secretary



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(VI) Mudgal Scholarship – 5 students per year

- 1. Class 12th students having annual family income less than Rs. 2.5 lakh.
- 2. Percentage of last qualifying exam (12th Board) 60% (Arts and commerce)
- 3. Percentage of last qualifying exam (12th Board) 70% (Science). Highest scorer will get priority in each course.
- 4. Note: The scholarship will be continued in 2nd and 3rd year if the student (All Streams) maintains minimum 60% in the last qualifying exams. Highest scorer will be get priority in each course.
- 5. Merit Award shall be granted up to 50% of the fees.
- 6. Final approval of students uder this scholarship shall be given by Director & Secretary
